Horse Registration papers & NCHA/CCHA/SCHA memberships required for owners & riders in NCHA/CCHA classes;

Two shows, one go round, no finals; classes may not run in order listed; SAM System in effect.

Riders may show 2 horses in the Open; Youth may ride stallions.

All fees are due on entries cancelled after the closing date. The only exceptions are where show management is provided a veterinary certificate declaring the horse disabled and unable to compete, or in the case of disabling injury to the rider, or serious sickness or death in his/her family; show management must be advised prior to the draw. In these cases only cattle charges are payable.

*SHSRA entries with youth classes. MUST HAVE SCHA & NCHA MEMBERSHIPS. Fees shown are fees per go.

**Two qualifying goes on Saturday, 2nd go SCHA approved only. FINALS on Sunday.

Senior World Tour (60+): Run as a class within an NCHA class, enter when making regular class entries;
Entry fee \$20: \$10 to jackpot, \$6 to NCHA, \$4 to SCHA; no entries after classes start.
