Horse registration papers and current SCHA memberships are required as well as NCHA/CCHA cards for NCHA/CCHA approved classes

Two shows. One each day. One go round, no finals. Classes may not run in the order listed.

S.A.M. system in place. Riders may ride 2 horses in the Open. Youth may ride stallions.

All fees are due on entries cancelled after the closing date. The only exceptions are where show management is provided a veterinary certificate declaring the horse disabled and unable to compete, or in the case of disabling injury to the rider, or serious sickness or death in his/her family; show management must be advised prior to the draw. In these cases only cattle charges are payable.

Senior World Tour (60+): Run as a class within an NCHA class, enter when making regular class entries;
Entry fee \$20: \$10 to jackpot, \$6 to NCHA, \$4 to SCHA; no entries after classes start.
